- Assembly. Perform sub-assemblies and final assembly:
 - o Gather parts and tools from the list and follow basic assembly instructions to complete mechanical and electrical assemblies following written and visual instructions.
 - o Follow safety procedures and practices and document work appropriately.
- **Testing.** You will be performing initial tests of the assembled machine.
- Other. Occasionally you may be asked to help with other jobs within the company, depending on our needs and your skills and interests.
